Adventurer Agreement

The Waterbury Adventure Challenge (WAC) is an immersive experience that will have you exploring Waterbury engaging in all types of physical activities, puzzles, and interacting with local businesses and people. It is important for you to acknowledge that the WAC is a self-serve event and it is NOT a closed course, but instead will be happening with live traffic, variable weather, uneven surfaces and may present other hazards for which you need to be responsible for your own safety and well-being. With this in mind the WAC needs all adventurers to agree to the below expectations:

- I agree to abide by all state, local, and business-specific COVID guidelines and recognize that I am not exempt from any posted rules about masks, distancing or other COVID-specific measures.
- □ I will respect all local businesses and their employees and I know that WAC adventurers are not entitled to extra attention or priority compared to their other customers.
- I know that WAC is a self-serve experience that does not have police closing local roads to traffic and will be responsible for my own safety when it comes to traffic, inclement weather, unmaintained trails and surfaces and other hazards that may be present.

Participants will need to provide their own transportation between locations, which requires the use of a vehicle. Some clues will require moderate hiking; contact <u>info@discoverwaterbury.com</u> for questions about accessibility.

Participants can work alone or in teams, but it is suggested that each group has access to at least one smartphone for the best experience. WAC is not suggested for children aged 5 and under.

There is no guarantee that you will be able to complete the Waterbury Adventure Challenge, although you are able to start, finish, and continue working on the challenges any time between May 28 and October 11, 2021.
